

# 2026 Yosemite Bible Camp Information Packet

## Who Can Attend?

- The age requirement for campers without a parent or guardian attending is **10 years old** (or going into the 5th grade) through seniors in High School (the school year beginning in the fall of 2025). Graduating seniors can still attend as campers, but must participate in all “camper” activities.
- Campers under 10 (“pre-campers”) are allowed if supervised by an accompanying parent **who has been approved to serve as staff**. Pre-campers must be housed with parents.
- All camper applications are subject to approval by the West Visalia elders and camp directors.
- Campers and parents need to be in agreement with the camp rules and requirements.
- For those desiring to be **staff**, you must first register online and pay your enrollment fees. **You will be contacted if you are approved as staff. Your registration fees will be refunded if you are not selected to serve.** Please contact Cliff Sabroe if you have any questions. All staff must submit to a criminal background check and pass a child safety course online and complete an online First Aid course - More info to be provided.

## What Do I Do Upon Arrival at YBC?

- Campers’ parents are responsible for providing and/or arranging transportation to and from the camp.
- Parents and campers should observe the camp dress code during the arrival and pick-up of campers. Start time at the camp is 4:00pm on Sunday June 28th. (Campers can start arriving at 2pm) Pick-up time is 9:30 am on Saturday, July 4th..
- **As staff and campers arrive, they should go to the cafeteria by 4:00pm to check in and get their cabin assignments and have their health screening.**
- **New For this Year:** *Camp Visitors/Guests are only allowed during the designated pick up and drop off times. Once camp begins, only enrolled campers and approved YBC staff (screened and trained) are allowed on the camp property.*

## How Do I Pay?

- **You pay 100% of the camp enrollment fees when registering online.** We are no longer offering a “pay upon arrival” option. All camp info is at [www.wvcoc.org/ybc](http://www.wvcoc.org/ybc)
- **YOUR FEE COVERS** food, bed, camp sports and games and camp t-shirt (shirt promised to those who register before June 1st). Your fee does not cover snack shack refreshments. You can purchase credit at the snack bar upon arriving at camp.

## Camp Rules:

- All campers are required to attend all worship services and Bible classes unless excused by the Camp Nurse.
- All campers will respect the property of all other campers and staff members.
- No foul language, dirty jokes or inappropriate comments will be tolerated.
- \*PDA (Public displays of Affection) between boy and girl campers will be limited to hand holding only.. Any relationships that do not represent Biblical morality, or any unwanted attention or affection that makes another feel uncomfortable is prohibited at camp.
- A nightly curfew of 10:30pm to 6:00am will be strictly enforced and all campers are to remain in their cabins during this time.
- \*Campers will not be allowed to leave the main camp area at any time unless accompanied by an adult staff member and approved by a Camp Director. Hikes and Creek trips must be chaperoned.
- **All prescription and non-prescription medication must be turned into the Camp Nurse immediately upon arrival at camp. The nurse will administer the required dosage.**
- Campers are discouraged from having money in their cabins. The camp is not responsible for money or valuables kept in the cabins and losses thereof.
- \*The girls are not to go in or around the boys cabins. \*The boys are not allowed to go in or around the girls cabins.

### What Not to Bring to Camp:

- \*Knives or weapons of any kind. No firecrackers, fireworks or sparklers or any kind..
- \*No Drugs, Any Tobacco Products, Vape Pens, Alcohol or Inappropriate Pictures of Any Kind
- **No Cell Phones are to be Used During Camp** - If campers need to use a cell phone to call home they may between 10:00pm and 10:30pm (before "lights out"). No texting or phone calls permitted between campers while at camp. Phones must be turned off and in the cabin during all other times. Staff are not to use cell phones in the presence of campers. **It is highly recommended that phones be left home.**
- No Computers - Staff may use computers for class preparation and other pertinent needs.
- Skateboards, scooters, bikes or skates are not allowed on camp property. Paintballs, Paintball Guns, or Airsoft guns should not be brought.. Don't bring anything that will mess up the camp.

### What To Bring to Camp:

- Bible, notebook and pen or pencils.
- Sleeping bag or bedding with pillows.
- Enough clothes, toiletries (ie. soap), and towels, for the week.
- We recommend labeling clothes with the camper's name.
- Swimming suit and sunscreen SPF 30 or higher and mosquito repellent. Inexpensive sports equipment to participate in recreational activities (labeled if possible).
- (Optional) Costumes for Themed Nights. (Themes to be announced soon)
- (Optional) Accessories for individual talent skits and participation in campfire programs.

### Disciplinary Actions:

- Camp disciplinary action, at the discretion of the directors or staff, may include K.P. and/or clean-up assignments, and loss of free time privileges. Disobeying the rules marked with an \* or cases of continual or serious misbehavior will result in the camper being sent home with parent or guardian responsible for transportation. We try to keep a positive fun environment at camp. If an individual is not willing to help the camp be a success, we will dismiss them.

### Camp Dress Code:

- Clothing should not have anything written on it that is not in keeping with Christian standards.
- Campers must be fully clothed going to and coming from the swimming pool.
- Clothing should not be immodest (i.e., not too tight or too revealing, etc.) **(If you have a question about your attire, ask your Cabin Leader).**
- No Lycra/spandex tights or form-fitting stretch pants may be worn in place of pants. **Leggings/Yoga Pants are not allowed.**
- No spaghetti-straps or crop tops may be worn at any time. No bare midriffs or low-cut tops. **No tank-tops.** (If you have a question about your attire, ask your Cabin Leader). (When in doubt, wear a camp t-shirt instead).
- Footwear/shoes must be worn at all times. Flip-flops should only be worn to and from the pool and showers.
- **Shorts to the middle of the thigh or longer** are allowed for both boys and girls. If they are too short you will be asked to change. Make sure they are in the middle of the thigh and past your fingers when hands are at your side.
- No jogging shorts, tight running shorts or spandex shorts. No clothing with revealing cutouts.
